The QLD University of Technology (QUT) Student Guild have prepared an open letter to their university administration, condemning the continuation of online content delivery despite very little or no interruptive Covid restrictions. Students at QUT have expressed frustration at the limitation of options and questionable standards with regard to in person class times, as well as reductions in contact hours and limited opportunity for face-to-face interactions for students. Most importantly, there was very little or no communication to students about what was to be expected this semester.
